

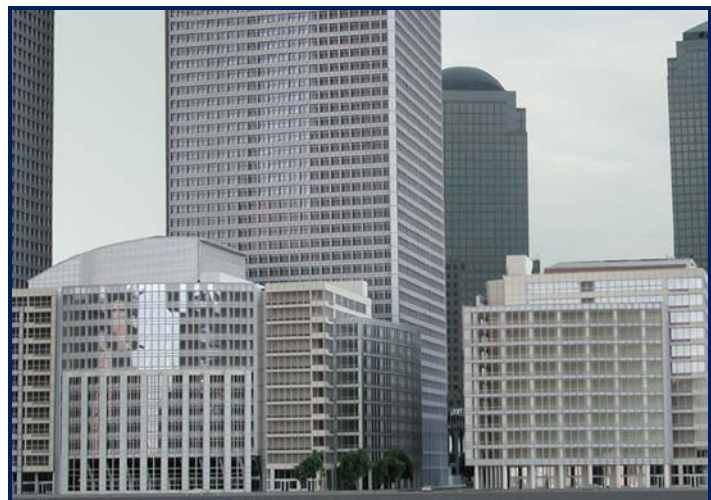
BETTER IN EVERY WAY
